Student Absences

As of the commencement of the 2017 school year the state government has mandated that ALL student absences must be advised by parents to the school. If your child is going to be absent for any reason please ring the school on 4126 8146 detailing the child's name, date of absence and reason for absence. If you ring early you can leave a message on our message bank. You can also ring in advance if you know that your child will be absent in the future.

If you have not contacted the school by 9am on the day of the absence you will receive a text message or phone call asking for you to ring the school or send a return text regarding your child's absence details.

This information is required to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all Queensland school students.

Student Resource Scheme for 2017

Invoices have been sent to all families for the 2017 Student Resource Scheme. If you have already paid for the resource scheme please ignore the invoice. Invoices must be created so that the payments can be receipted against them. Receipting will be done next week.

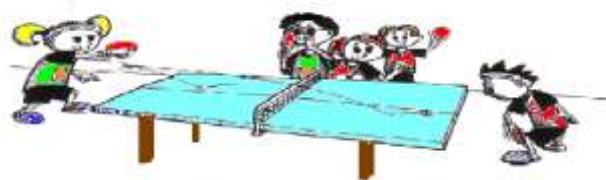
