The next 5 weeks at Goodwood are going to be busy. We have an assortment of activities taking place over the coming weeks that will keep us on our toes.

Celebration Day

Over the last few weeks we have fielded a few questions regarding the points system we employ for Celebration Day. Each term we hold a Celebration Day to reward the great behaviour and attendance of our students. Students have the chance to earn a Gold, Silver or Bronze invitation to these days. These different invitations are earned via daily points. Each child has the chance to earn a point if they **attend school** and make **appropriate behaviour** choices on that day. A total of 48 points can be earned this term as we have 48 school days this term. Given that attendance and behaviour are contributing factors in earning an invitation to Celebration Day, we have a sliding scale of points that must be earned to receive an invitation. This allows for a bout of illness, medical appointments and the odd inappropriate behaviour choice.

Gold	44 – 48 points
Silver	38 – 43 points
Bronze	33 – 37 points
