- Ensure greater alignment of A-E results with other systemic forms of assessment.
- Ensure all students achieve above the National Minimum Standard for all areas of NAPLAN assessment with the following Upper Two Bands (U2B) targets -
 - Year 3 Reading – 30%
 - Year 3 Numeracy – 30%
 - Year 5 Reading – 30%
 - Year 5 Numeracy – 30%.

Our initiatives include

Strengthening pedagogical practice to improve learning through:


- Implementation of North Coast Region Small Schools English Plan to facilitate greater alignment between A-E data and other systemic assessment
- Continued implementation of Daily Rapid Reading to improve literacy for identified students
- Increasing teacher capacity around teaching a whole school phonics and reading program
- Building teachers' ability to interpret data to enhance student learning programs through the effective use of diagnostic assessment
- Using a school wide process of coaching, feedback and best practice pedagogy implementation.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Purchasing additional teacher aide hours to work with identified students using the Daily Rapid Reading program **\$14 545**
- Release teachers to undertake training and professional development in Daily Rapid Reading, Teaching Handwriting, Reading and Spelling Skills (THRASS) and North Coast Regions Small School English Plan **\$ 4 310**
- Provide teacher release time for the development of planning, coaching and feedback purposes **\$ 3 045**
